

Dr. Jennifer Liu, MD, FACC, is Associate Professor of Clinical Medicine at Weill Cornell Medical College in New York, NY. Dr. Liu is also Clinical Member and Attending Physician at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, in New York, NY. Since her arrival at MSKCC in 2007, Dr. Liu built a career as a cardio-oncologist and leader in the field of echo imaging in the evaluation and management of cardiotoxicity in patients during and after cancer therapy. Her goal as a cardio-oncologist and echocardiographer is to apply imaging to improve the management of cardiovascular disease of patients during and after cancer therapy. Dr. Liu is fulfilling that goal through clinical care, research and education.

Dr. Liu leads one of the largest cardio-oncology echo labs in the world and has refined advanced echo-imaging techniques that provide sensitive and early detection of cardiotoxicity. Dr. Liu has lectured at major scientific meetings and she was part of the American Society of Echo (ASE) writing group that produced the first expert consensus document on the use of echo imaging in patients during and after cancer therapy. Dr. Liu is a member of the American College of Cardiology Cardio-Oncology Leadership Council and she serves on the ACC.org Cardio-Oncology Editorial Team charged with selection of relevant publications and creating educational resources for the College. She plans to continue her leadership role in a collaborative relationship to define practice standards and setting best practices in cardio-oncology.
