

Carole A. Warnes, MD, FRCP, FACC, is Professor of Medicine, a Consultant in the Department of Cardiovascular Diseases and Pediatric Cardiology, and Founder of the Adult Congenital Heart Disease Clinic at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota. Dr. Warnes's expertise includes congenital heart disease in children and adults, and pregnancy and cardiac disease.

Dr. Warnes has been a member of the American College of Cardiology Board of Trustees for 7 years. She is Former Co-chair of the American College of Cardiology/American Heart Association Guidelines for the Management of Adult Congenital Heart Disease. She is a member of the American Society of Echocardiography, Alliance for Continuing Medical Education, and Society for Academic Continuing Medical Education. Dr. Warnes is a fellow of the Royal College of Physicians. She is Past President of the International Society for Adult Congenital Cardiac Disease.

Dr. Warnes is the author or coauthor of more than 200 articles, 3 books, and several book chapters. Her articles and abstracts are published in prestigious, peer-reviewed scientific journals, including *Circulation*, *Journal of the American Medical Association*, and *Journal of the American College of Cardiology*. She is a reviewer for *American Heart Journal*, *Annals of Internal Medicine*, *Circulation*, *European Heart Journal*, and *New England Journal of Medicine*, among others. Dr. Warnes also has been a member of the editorial boards for *American Journal of Cardiology*, *Heart*, and *Circulation*. A sought-after speaker, she has delivered more than 450 local, regional, national, and international invited presentations in her field.

Dr. Warnes earned her MD with commendation at Newcastle Upon Tyne Medical School in England. After graduating, she completed her residencies in cardiology at National Heart Hospital in London and the London Chest Hospital. She completed her postgraduate thesis at the National Institutes of Health before returning to the National Heart Hospital in London as a British Heart Foundation Scholar and Senior Registrar.

Dr. Warnes is a recipient of the Mayo Clinic Henry S. Plummer Distinguished Physician Award, Mayo Clinic Distinguished Educator Award, American Heart Association Laennec Master Clinician Award, American College of Cardiology Distinguished Fellow Award, and Mayo Clinic Lifetime Achievement for Outstanding Contributions to Medical Education. A gifted teacher, she also earned the Mayo Clinic Department of Medicine Leadership in Education Award and she is an 8-time winner of the Mayo Clinic Cardiovascular Division Outstanding Teacher of the Year Award.
