

Roxana Mehran, MD, FACC, FACP, FAHA, FCCP, FESC, FSCAI, is Professor of Medicine in Cardiology, Professor of Population Health Science and Policy, and Director of Interventional Cardiovascular Research and Clinical Trials at the Zena and Michael A. Weiner Cardiovascular Institute at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, New York. Her clinical activities are focused on patients with Acute Coronary Syndrome, Angina, Cardiac Catheterization, Coronary Artery Disease, Coronary Stenting, High Blood Pressure, High Cholesterol, Hyperlipidemia. Dr. Mehran is internationally recognized for her work as a clinical trial specialist with complex data analyses and outcomes research within the field of interventional cardiology and for her experience and expertise in working with regulatory agencies to design and conduct clinical trials.

Dr. Mehran has served as Course Co-Director of the annual Transcatheter Cardiovascular Therapeutics (TCT) since 1996. She serves on the editorial board of several peer reviewed journals, served on the board of trustees of SCAI, a member of the board of directors for Harboring Hearts, co-founder of SCAI Women in Innovation (SCAI-WIN), and a founding physician of the Cardiovascular Research Foundation in New York, where she is currently Chief Scientific Officer. Dr. Mehran is a recipient of numerous honors and awards, most recently the 2018 Wenger Award for Excellence in Medical Leadership, and the 2017 ACC Bernadine Healy Leadership in Women's CV Disease Distinguished Award.
