

Dr. Warnes is the Penske Foundation Professor of Clinical Medicine and a consultant in the Department of Cardiovascular Diseases and Pediatric Cardiology at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota.

She received her medical degree from Newcastle upon Tyne University in England and then the National Heart Hospital in London. Here she developed an interest in adult congenital heart disease (ACHD) after working with Jane Somerville. She had 2 years at National Institutes of Health (NIH) in the United States before returning to the National Heart Hospital in London for another two years as a British Heart Foundation Scholar and Senior Registrar working in ACHD.

She joined the Department of Cardiovascular Diseases at Mayo Clinic in 1987, where she founded the Adult Congenital Heart Disease Clinic. She is passionate about clinical practice and education and has trained about 30 fellows in ACHD with many of them leading ACHD practices around the world. Dr. Warnes is the Dean of Mayo School of Continuing Medical Education for 10 years.
